


Modo de enseñanza: Este programa se enseña en el aula de clases y mediante autoestudio.

1 NIVEL - BEGINNER

2 NIVEL - ELEMENTARY

- Al finalizar el nivel de Elementary, los estudiantes comprenderán y utilizarán frases esenciales relacionadas con temas inmediatos como la familia, las compras y el empleo. Participarán con confianza en conversaciones sencillas sobre temas cotidianos e interactuarán de manera efectiva en diversas situaciones cotidianas.

5 NIVEL - UPPER INTERMEDIATE

En el nivel Upper Intermediate, los estudiantes comprenden textos extensos, captan significados implícitos y se comunican con fluidez en contextos sociales, académicos y profesionales. Desarrollan contenido escrito y bien estructurado.

6 NIVEL - ADVANCED

En el nivel advanced, los estudiantes comprenden y resumen sin esfuerzo información de diversas fuentes, presentando argumentos coherentes. Se expresan de forma espontánea y precisa incluso en situaciones complejas.



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
